The Source of Strength & Motivation

I. Embrace the principle of sowing and reaping.

— **Matthew 6:19–20** | *Don’t store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy and where thieves break in and steal. But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys, and where thieves don’t break in and steal.* (CSB)

— **2 Corinthians 5:10** | *For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each may be repaid for what he has done in the body, whether good or evil.* (CSB)

II. Know the time.

A. There is an appointed harvest time.

B. There is an expected time to sow.

III. Focus on the harvest.

— **Hebrews 12:1-2** | *Therefore, since we also have such a large cloud of witnesses surrounding us, let us lay aside every hindrance and the sin that so easily ensnares us. Let us run with endurance the race that lies before us, keeping our eyes on Jesus, the source and perfecter of our faith. For the joy that lay before him, he endured the cross, despising the shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.* (CSB)
