God made us male and female (**Gen 1:26-28**). He made no distinction between sex and gender. Our gender is indicated by our sex. Any denial of one's gender or sex assigned at birth is sin. And he created sexuality for marriage which he intends to be between one man and one woman joined together in a life-long covenant commitment (**Mat 19:3-6**).

God's purpose for sexuality is for having children and for strengthening the marriage bond (Gen 1:28, 2:24; 1 Cor 7:1-5, 6:16). Any sexual activity outside of God's intention for marriage is sin (1 Cor 6:9-20, 1 Thess 4:3-8, 1 Tim 1:9-10, Rom 1:18-32).

Sexual sin is sin against God, against our own bodies (1 Cor 6:18), and against those we have wronged through it (1 Thess 4:6), and it is ultimately harmful for humanity (Rom 5:12-14, 6:21).
