

“Christ Crucified”

“. . . *The Son of Man is to be delivered up for crucifixion.*”(Matthew 26:2; Isaiah 52:13-53:12)

Passion means “having suffered”

Isaiah 53:4

“*Stricken*” – to beat; to give a blow; an infliction

“*Smitten*” – to strike; to beat; to kill

“*Afflicted*” – to look down; to browbeat; to hurt

Isaiah 53:5

“*Pierced*” – to wound; to bore through; to pierce

“*Crushed*” – to be broken into pieces; bruised

“*Chastening*” – to punish with blows

“*Scourging*” – stripes; blood blisters

I. His Back Was Lacerated.

“*I gave My back to those who strike Me*” (Isaiah 50:6a; Cf. Matthew 27:26b)

II. His Brow Was Scarred.

“*And after weaving a crown of thorns, they put it on His head . . .*” (Matthew 27:29)

“*And My cheeks to those who pluck the beard; I did not cover My face from humiliation and spitting.*” (Isaiah 50:6b)

“*Then they spat in His face and beat Him with their fists; and others slapped Him*”
(Matthew 26:67)

III. His Hands Were Nailed.

“*Unless I shall see in His hands the imprint of the nails . . .*” (John 20:25)

IV. His Feet Were Pierced.

“*See My hands and My feet, that it is I Myself: touch Me and see . . .*” (Luke 24:39-40)

V. His Side Was Pierced.

“*But one of the soldiers pierced His side with a spear . . .*” (John 19:34)

VI. His Appearance Was Marred.

“. . . *His appearance was marred more than any man . . .*” (Isaiah 52:14)
